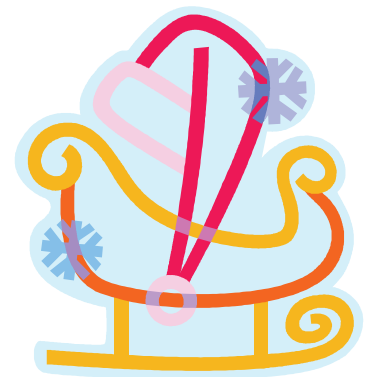

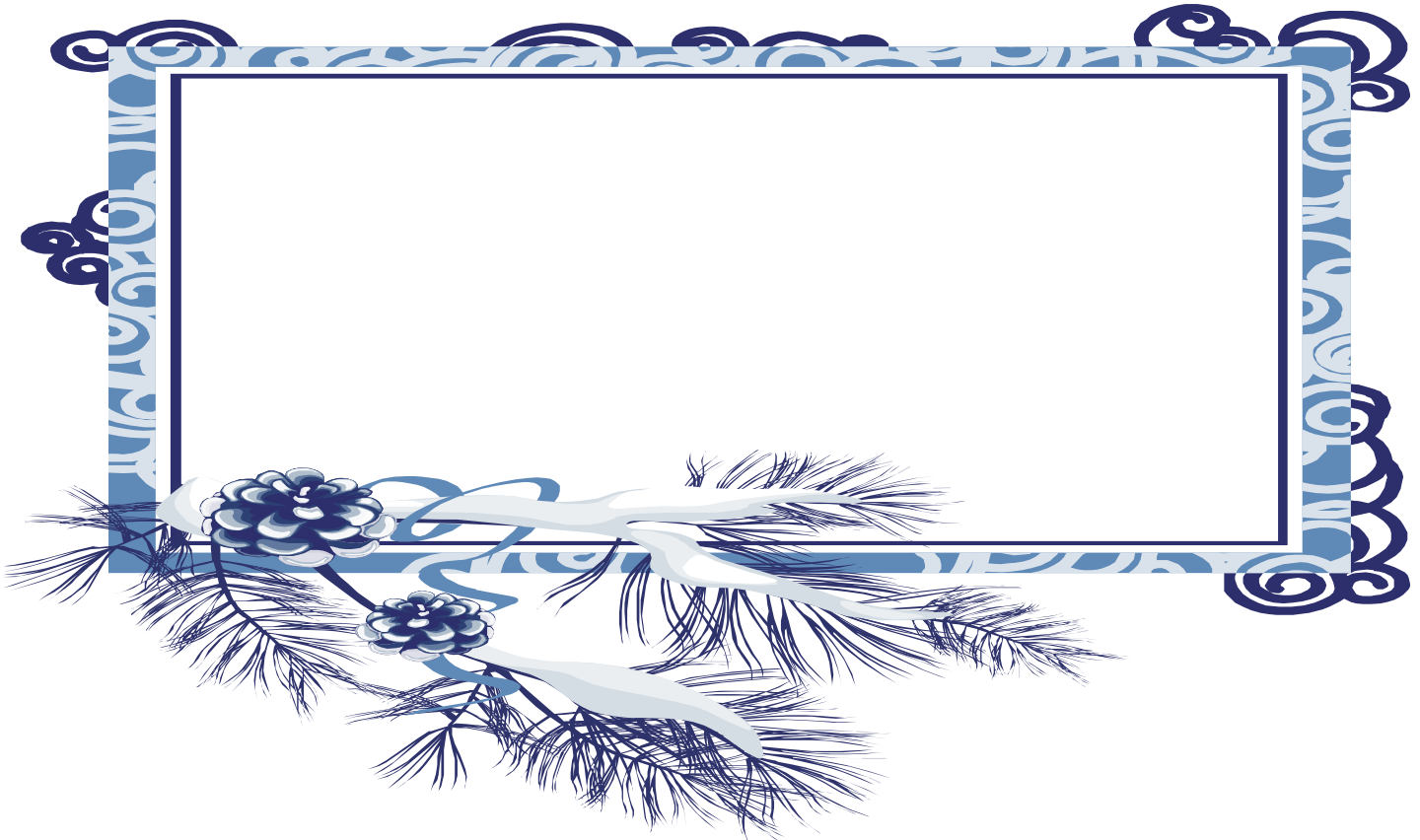

Maintenance News

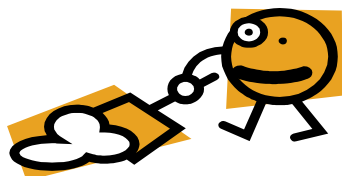
It's that time once again. Fall and then Winter .
